Barboleuse	Muddy spring
Bex	BEIS is the name of a Gallo-roman estate
Bois de la Glaive	Steeply sloping terrain
Brettaye	A crossroads
Cergnement	An enclosed mountain pasture.
Chaux Ronde	Unproductive pasture above the tree line
Chesieres	A dairy or group of cottages
Coufin	a boundary area Ggryon/Ollon (located next to the Gryonne river)
Exergillod	Run down and overgrown
Forchex	Forked road or wood
Gryon	to do with chalk and gypsum
Huemoz	no idea
La Pousaz	A place to pause after a steep climb
La Truche	steep rock with a flat top or an assembly such a a bale of straw?
Lac des Chavonnes	Part of the Chavonnes pasture, chavon means end piece (of land)
Le Chamossaire	Got Chamois
Les Combes	A small valley
Les Ecovets	Bushes and Brambles
Les Rapes	Attractive Forests
Meilleret	In the middle
Ormonts	Bear Mountain
Palluyeres	A marshy area
Panex	no idea
Plambuit	Flat surface surrounded by wood
Plan D'Essert	Run down and overgrown
Roc D'Orsay	Rock of the bears
Solalex	Under the wall (of the Mirroir d'Agentine etc)
Taveyanne	Tavillons are wooden shingles
